

WILDLIFE ART CONTEST



RULES



1. Students in **3rd through 12th grades** may enter contest
2. **Multiple entries allowed** (but each entry must be a different animal)
 - **only native birds & mammals accepted** (no reptiles, amphibians, insects or fish)
3. Winning artwork will be on title page of each chapter (and throughout book)
4. Published artwork will be credited in book to student
5. No money or royalties will be awarded for published work
6. Published **PA Wildlife Journal** will be for sale to the general public
7. Submitted artwork should be in **COLOR**
8. No artwork larger than 8 1/2 x 11 inches (no larger than this page)
9. No framed or matted artwork accepted. No 3-dimensional work accepted
10. Any pastel or charcoal work must be fixed to avoid smearing
11. **All artwork must have the following written clearly on the back of entry:**
 - your name
 - your age & grade
 - your school & school district
 - your home address
 - your home phone number
 - the name of your animal
12. Be creative, but make sure your bird or mammal can be identified as a specific species (don't just draw or paint a duck - draw or paint a canvasback or a pintail)
13. Winning artwork becomes property of York County Conservation District
14. Artwork can only be returned as per the specific rules on our website
15. Entries accepted now / contest open until all suitable art is chosen
16. Public art show will coincide with publication of the **PA Wildlife Journal**
17. Entries may be hand-delivered or mailed. Scanned images may be emailed. No faxes.
