How will my artwork be judged?



- **Artwork will be judged on how well it depicts a particular species**

& how well it fits into the composition of the book.

- Some artwork may be very primitive,
some may be realistic.

If we like it, we will use it.

- **We like a lot of different kinds of wildlife art,**

so be yourself & do your best.

- **Creativity is encouraged,**

but make sure your animal can be identified.

- **Be specific:**

Do not submit just a “duck.”

Choose a particular species: a canvasback or a bufflehead.

Readers need to know at a glance which species they are looking at.

- **Field marks are important to identification—**

like the white spots on a fawn or the white eye stripe on a Carolina wren

- **Not every animal listed will be included in the book,**

but we won't know which species we are using until

we see the artwork.
