



## YCCD K10 Trees Guidelines

- The applicant must be the landowner, or have written permission from the landowner, and be a District cooperator.
- If located on an ag operation, the applicant must have a current Agricultural Erosion & Sediment Control/Conservation Plan and/or Manure Management Plan and be implementing it.
- Trees will only be offered by the District during the fall planting season. Orders will be submitted in the summer. Requests received for the spring planting season will be forwarded to other area partners.
- All landowner requests sent directly by the Chesapeake Bay Foundation to the District will be forwarded to other area partners.
- Plantings must be a minimum of 50 stems.
- If planting along a stream, the buffer must be a minimum of 15 feet.
- The landowner is responsible for all maintenance of the trees/shrubs and shelters.
- Fall plantings with 300+ stems will qualify for District-coordinated volunteers to assist in planting. The landowner will be responsible for plantings under 300 stems.
